The two main pieces of law that apply are: The EU general data protection regulation 2016 (also known as GDPR), and The data protection act 2018 We rely on the following as the lawful bases on which we collect and use your personal data: GDPR Article 6(1)(e): the processing is necessary for the performance of its official tasks carried out in the public interest in providing and managing a health service GDPR Article 9(2)(h): the processing is necessary for the management of health or social care systems and services GDPR Article 9(2)(i): the processing is necessary for reasons of public interest in the area of public health
