

Anti- Social Behaviour (ASB)

Definition

If an individual or groups quality of life is impacted by other individuals or groups in the community, it is deemed as ASB. Examples include; noise nuisance, neighbour disputes, verbal abuse, intimidating/threatening behaviour, harassment, vandalism and criminal damage.

Questions that are relevant

- Do you feel intimidated/ worried by a neighbours behaviour? Is it impacting your quality of life?
- Is this the first incident or are there a number of occurrences? If this is enduring have you previously reported this to the local authority and the police?
- Do you feel safe?

Best practice

- Report to landlord- they have a duty of care to ensure tenants are not breaching their agreement
- Report to local council or ASB/ Housing Officer (Build evidence so that actions can be escalated)
- Do you feel safe?
